

SELECTMEN'S MONDAY MEETING, November 9, 1987

Meeting called to order at 7:30 P.M.

Checks were signed.

Chris Joseph gave his weekly police report.

Rachel Reinstein requested executive session to discuss personnel matter.  
Seconded by Edwin Rowehl.

Meeting was called to order.

Mrs. Tarbell and Mr. Gavit requested a letter be signed regarding the newly  
constructed Beaver Road. Selectmen refused to sign the letter until all work  
is completed. Such as loam needing replaced on a neighboring property.

Dave Boule' explained his plans to remove two buildings on his property and  
build enclosures over two area which contain his building materials. They will  
not be visible from the road and will not result in an extension of the  
business, rather just protection to the already existing supplies. Selectmen  
approved the building permit.

Mr. Page showed Selectmen the 1941 deed for the property known as the Reel  
Shop.

Mr. Page took the opportunity of the appointment to ask if a special exception  
was granted to a property owner on Gregg Lake who is running a "school".  
Antrim zoning required a special exception for a school on property of less  
than five acres. The property in question is not two acres. Selectmen agreed  
to look into the matter.
