Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting. January 19. 1988

Present: John Jones. Rachel Reinstein. Edwin Rowehl.

The Selectmen met with Water Commissioners. Tenney and Pratt. David Kittredge. water project engineer. Jim Cruthers. Dennis McKenney. forester and two representativies from Natgun Co. There was a slide showing to insustrate the step-by-step process of building a tank on site. The contract between Natgun and the Town was signed by John Jones with Edwin Rowehl as witness.

By unanimous vote the Board went into executive session to discuss a personnel matter and later reconvened.

Building permits were reviewed and signed for: Fred and Marguerite Roberts to convert a house back to its previous use as a two family house: Shaw to build a new house, and Sean Hickey to add an apartment to the former Moore house on West Street.

The selectmen then conferred with the Water Commissioners and the engineer on the best way to handle the resurfacing of Pleasant Street after the relaying of pipe. It was decided that B. Pratt would confer with the road agent to see if it would be possible to have the trench filled by the contractors for temporary use with final finishing and paving being done by the town highway crew at less cost.

It was decided to get an opinion from L. Phillips Runyon of Peterborough regarding presentation of the proposed new zoning ordinance for voting.

A decision was also made to use the Peterborough Transcript for printing the town report.
