

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, June 20, 1988

Present: Rachel C. Reinstein, Chairman, Edwin Rowehl and John Jones.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 PM.

Mr. Arthur Stenberg met with Selectmen to discuss the opening for a zoning enforcement officer. Mr. Stenberg was interested in the position and agreed to wait for a written response from the Selectmen.

Rachel Reinstein, Edwin Rowehl and John Jones agreed Mr. Stenberg would fill the requirements for the zoning enforcement officer.

A job description will be sent along with schedule of fee payments and if Mr. Stenberg agrees to both, the Selectmen will swear Mr. Stenberg in as a zoning enforcement officer.

Selectmen agreed to have the telephone # of all filing building applications on the application. Mr. Stenberg will then call to set a time to view the site to see that the area for the proposed building conforms with the plot plan submitted by the applicant.

Certificate of occupancies will be required on new constructions.

Selectmen discussed extending the time in which they must act on a permit from the two weeks to possible ten to twenty days which would allow for inspection of the property. No permits will be approved the first Monday the Selectmen see them.

The Selectmen will establish an inspection fee based on type of construction in order to cover the cost to the Town for the zoning inspector.
