SELECTMEN'S MEETING, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 1989

Present: Rachel C. Reinstein, Chairman, Edwin F. Rowehl, William Suydam, Madeleine Henley, Administrative Assistant and Art Stenberg, Zoning Inspector.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 PM.

Building permit #89003 for D. Breault. Mr. Breault will be advised to contact the State regarding a driveway onto a State Road and request a report be sent to the Selectmen's office.

Possible violations were discussed.

Permits #89004 and 89005 were given to Art Stenberg to be checked out.

Mark Tenney informed Selectmen of a voter guide completed by his school study committee and asked for funds to have copies made. Bill Suydam made a motion to pay for the guides. Ed Rowehl second, so moved.

Information received from Chuck Knox, Water Supply and Pollution Control, regarding pollutants going into the lakes was discussed.

A warrant must be drawn up or lay out procedures begun in order to answer the petition request of Mr. Foley regarding Beaver Dam Road. It was agreed a warrant will be written.

Shelley Nelkins has been calling Bill Suydam. Bill is upset to hear Shelley has not filed the evacuation report. She has refused to hand over any information concerning the landfill. A question of the Right to Know was raised. Is it legal to withhold information gathered while Shelley was representing the Town? Or was she acting as a private citizen.

The Hyland property was discussed, as well as the budget and change of polling place.

Mike Beauchamp will be called to clear the use of two firemen to be stationed at the Fire House during voting.

Dennis McKenney will do the Town maps. A letter will be sent to Don Mellen requesting the maps.
