Meeting called to order at 10:00 AM.

Letters from Runyon regarding the Hickey property and the Hyland property were discussed.

Bill questioned if the selectmen can do anything with the Hyland situation now that the lawyers have suggested an agreement be met as to the time for removal of the building. Ed suggested speaking to Phil Runyon.

Bill and Ed agreed to have all building permits which the zoning inspector finds free of problems, can be dropped off at the office during the week for selectmen's signature. This will free time on Monday Evenings for other business. When Art finds a problem he will be requested to come in and report why the permit should be disapproved.

Building Permit #89016 was approved.

A portion of timber tax was abated on the Olson operation due to poor quality of wood and difficult operation.

Dennis McKenney' proposal to update the tax maps was approved and accepted.

Warrant for the collection of timber tax will be signed during the week.

To protect public safety all septic systems in the vicinity of Gregg Lake and Great Brook shall be tested as required by the Antrim Board of Health by June 15, 1989 (RSA 128:3 & RSA 147). Septic Systems on all properties accessible from Gregg Lake Rd. and White Birch Point Road, or whose property lines fall within 500 feet of Great Brook are subject to testing. Property owners will be responsible for scheduling testing through the office of the selectmen. Moved by William Suydam, second by Edwin Rowehl. So moved.

A letter requiring a waver on the Vanski property was signed. Permit held pending receipt of same.
