

Selectmen's Meeting, December 03, 1990.

Phil Dwight, treasurer, will secure a note from the Peterborough Savings Bank for \$75,000 at 7 1/2% to cover the warrant article on corrosion control.

The BOS approved and signed the note for the above.

Arthur Stenberg, zoning enforcement officer, reviewed the Cutter property walk way.

Ed moved to release \$7,000 of the landscaping bond retaining \$500 until it can be determined that the seed has taken. Don Second. all in favor. So moved.

George Musler from the office of emergency management will be in tomorrow to discuss flood zones.

Art presented a proposed budget for 1991. The overall budget was decreased.

The Road Agent will be checking the Liberty Farm Bridge. A bond should be posted for the development on West St.

An appointment will be set to see Marie Slugaski regarding the opening on the Planning Board.

Phil Dwight requested a copy of the letter to Bennington regarding the landfill.

Phil also asked formally for a delay in filling the AA position being vacated by Madeleine.

A date for the public budget hearing has not as yet been scheduled. It is usually scheduled along with candidates nights some time in February. Phil suggested having a preliminary hearing in January giving time for the taxpayers to have a say in the budget planning. Phil has offered assistance in putting together a budget.
