

SELECTMEN'S MEETING
July 1, 1991

Attendance: Chairman Ed Rowehl, Don Phelps and Phil Dwight

Meeting called to order at 7:30 by Chairman Rowehl.

Selectmen signed the property tax abatement for H. Page to adjust taxes on property which had been placed in current use but mistakenly taxed at full assessed valuation.

Approved and signed the jury list for Hillsborough Superior court for the 1991-1992 season.

Signed an Intent-To-Cut for James Folley.

Reviewed a letter from Mr & Mrs Barry Roy regarding the Breezy Point road. Issues raised were the posting of a "Private Drive" sign at a point 100 feet short of the end of the road and the fact that their drive has suffered due to runoff from the newly rebuilt road. Referred the first issue to Road Agent Bob Varnum and the second issue to the Planning Board for their follow-up.

Discussed abatement request from David & Jane Corliss for their property on Pierce Lake road. Tabled the request pending additional information.

It was moved by Phelps and seconded by Dwight to waive the building permit fee for the Vayens property on Route 9. Habitat for Humanity will be building new dwelling on the site. Approved 3-0.

Sherman O'Brien and Bob Holmes of the US Post Office joined the meeting at 7:55 to discuss the idea of the town adopting street numbers for all properties. This would assist both the Post Office in making mail deliveries and emergency services in responding to 911 calls.

Moved by Phelps and seconded by Dwight to enter Executive Session per RSA 91-A:3b at 8:00 pm to interview prospective Police Chief candidates. Approved 3-0.

Moved by Phelps and seconded by Dwight to end executive session at 10:00 pm with no action to report. Approved 3-0.

P. Dwight reported back to the board that he had contacted the Greenfield Board of Selectmen to indicate our interest in attending a joint selectmen's meeting to discuss school funding issues. They thanked us for responding and will be in touch as the issue develops.

Issue of unresolved Shea Field lease with CONVAL school district discussed. A follow-up with the committee working on the lease is necessary.

P. Dwight moved to approve the minutes of June 24, 1991 with corrections as noted on the minutes, second by E. Rowehl. Approved 3-0.

Moved by P. Dwight to adjourn at 10:25 pm, second by E. Rowehl with all in favor.
