Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, August 5, 1991

7:30 Meeting called to order.

In answer to the concerns of some taxpayers, the Selectmen will place a sign at the Gregg Lake Dam. Sign to read, diving from dam is dangerous and prohibited. Ann Dwight agreed to make the sign which will be attached to the well house by the dam.

Jane and David Glines have purchased a piece of property on Gregg Lake. Since the property is accessible by water only, the former owner purchased a thirty foot easement to the property which was part of the sale. Mr. & Mrs. Glines requested permission to use the 30' ROW for a driveway to open onto Brimstone Corner. The portion of road involved is class VI and is not maintained by the town. The selectmen requested Mr. & Mrs. Glines return with a sketch of the proposed driveway. The plans will be reviewed by the Conservation Committee as this is a scenic road. The road agent will also have to approve the plans. The Selectmen cautioned that if permission is granted to open the proposed driveway onto the class VI road, the Town will continue maintaining only the class V portion of the road.

Ed will check with the school regarding traffic to and from the school property.

A copy of the K.D.K. writ of summons will be sent to Bart Mayer.

Minutes of last week are to reflect a correction. It was Don who suggested accepting funds from interested persons to pay for the new road signs, not Phil.
