Minutes of the Antrim Board of Selectmen November 4, 1991

Present: Edwin Rowehl, Chairman; Dave Boule and Phil Dwight, Selectmen; D. Penny, S. Crowell and J. Smith, members of Landfill Committee.

Mr. Leon Geil, Consulting Engineer met with the group to discuss the use of his services by the Town should it be decided that the Town would build its own transfer recycling station after the Bennington Landfill closes. After discussion Mr. Boule moved to employ Mr. Geil to do a specific site visit to advise on the suitability of that parcel as a possible location. Second P. Dwight. So moved.

Mr. Crowell asked the Selectmen whether they had scheduled meetings with Town Counsel, and if so, would they discuss with him the status of his tax abatement case. Mr. Rowehl indicated that there were no regular meetings with Counsel but the Selectmen would check on the case.

Mr. Hugh Giffin asked the Selectmen about the Inventory Penalty Tax. He noted that the wording on the form was ambiguous about the penalty. The Selectmen indicated that they would check whether there had been a change in the law.

Brian Brown, Police Chief, met to discuss his department's 1991 budget. The Selectmen generally agreed with the presentation.

Dave Boule moved to accept the minutes of October 28. Second, Ed Rowehl second. So moved.

Phil Dwight moved to approve the abatement application of Jacob Ruoff for 424.16. D. Boule second. So moved.

The Selectmen agreed to obtain 1992 Inventory Forms.

Dave Boule made the motion to adjourn. Second Phil Dwight. Meeting adjourned at 9:55 P.M.
