

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, January 18, 1993

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

Present: Phil Dwight, Chairman, Dave Boule', Mike Oldershaw,  
Brian Brown, Police Chief and Bob Varnum, Road Agent.

The first item on the agenda was salary increases for Town  
Employees.

Mike suggested a one time lump sum payment while Phil suggested a  
% increase for all employees. After some discussion Phil  
motioned to give a 4% increase effective April 1 to all Town  
Employees who have worked for the Town more than six months and  
also effective April 1 the new rate of medical deductions would  
become effective. Second Dave. Dave and Phil voted yes, Mike  
voted no.

Brian discussed his request for his previous time to be  
recognized for vacation. The Selectmen denied his request and  
pointed out that if he received this than others in Town  
Employment would qualify now and maybe in the future.

A veterans exemption was granted to Kevin Spaulding.

Phil Dwight will check with Phil Germain on having a hazardous  
waste pickup this year.

Dave Cutter requested a release of funds on Touchwood Square for  
work done. All but \$2,500 were released which is for seeding and  
sidewalks.

Dave made a motion to abate Maruzen-Hawthorne interest of \$67.54  
which was for a late charge. Motion was approved.

With no other business, meeting adjourned at 9:15.
