

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, February 22, 1993

Present: Dave Boule', Mike Oldershaw and Betty Shaw, Secretary.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

Michelle Sands who operates the beauty salon on Main Street explained how the two hour parking on Main St. was a problem for some of her clients who require up to four hours work on their hair. She asked if it would be possible to set aside some parking areas for four hours in place of the two hour limits. Dave who operates the store complains when someone is parking over the two hour time limit. Selectmen will speak to Brian Brown, Police Chief to see what his thoughts are. They will also look into using the Goodell parking lot on Aiken St.

A fair hearing for a welfare client will be held on Friday at 11 AM.

Bob Bryer stopped in to ask if he had to pay a yield tax which was billed to him since he did not pay for the cut nor receive any money for the wood.
