

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, March 22, 1993

Present: Phil Dwight, Chairman, Dave Boule', Tom Davis,
Selectmen and Betty Shaw, Secretary.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

Selectmen signed the bond application for the landfill closure,
note for the firetruck, MS 5, and letter of commitment to join
with Hancock for a hazardous waste pick up on June 5th. The time
has not been set yet.

All Town roads are closed to heavy trucking until May 15th.

Dave moved to accept the minutes of March 15th. Second, Tom.
All in favor. So moved.

Bob Bagloe, Pat Beers, Dot and Dave Penny spoke to the selectmen
about hiring a person to schedule the gym and ball fields. After
some discussion it was agreed that Bob Wilson, Pat Maynard, Pat
Webber, Pat Beers and Dave Boule' will form a committee. They
will be responsible for developing a job description for the
position, and placing the add in the newspapers. Applicants will
be screened by the Park Dept.. The Board of Selectmen will make
the final decision as to who will be hired for the part time
position. The person who is hired will be responsible to the
Park & Recreation committee who are in turn responsible to the
Selectmen.

User fees for the use of the gym was discussed as well as the
need to have someone responsible for seeing to any needed repairs
to the gym.

Brian Brown discussed evaluation forms. Selectmen will make some
changes to the personnel policy in regard to evaluations and
probation periods. Nothing final was decided at this meeting.

Brian informed the selectmen that 34 cats were inoculated at the
rabies clinic this past week end.

The radar is in need of repair which will cost about \$500. The
cost of a new radar would be \$2,600 and \$585 to rebuild the
present one.
