

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, February 21, 1994

Meeting called to order at 7 PM.

Present: Phil Dwight, Chairman, Dave Boule', Tom Davis and Betty Shaw, Secretary.

Tom moved to accept the minutes of February 7th as written. Second, Dave. All in favor. So moved.

A letter will be sent to a property owner relative to two dwellings on one property. Property under CUV is large enough for subdivision to bring into compliance.

Selectmen reviewed the proposed budget. Police dispatch is up \$2,000 over proposed budget figure. The highway budget is a concern as the costs have gone over the proposed budget amounts. Selectmen will meet with the road agent on the 7th and make a decision if they will revise the budget at town meeting.

The selectmen will not be meeting on the 28th.

7:20 Phil requested executive session to discuss legal settlements. All approved. No information from executive session when the meeting reconvened at 7:35.

Pat Maynard gave the selectmen a report on the use of the gym. It will be filed in the Parks and Recreation file. From 15 to 25 people use the gym on Thursday, 35 to 40 on Friday and 50 or more on Saturday. The center will be open one afternoon a week for the lower grades.

Brenda and Dot Penny were in favor of having Jan Wilson help Pat out by sharing hours with her. Pat does the scheduling of the gym and Jan will assist and do the scheduling of the fields. Tom moved to approve hiring Jan subject to background check. Second Dave. All in favor. So moved.

Pat Maynard was concerned over not being able to discuss the position with the selectmen and Pat Beers, but Pat Beers had to cancel out for this evening and it was best to get the assistance now.

Pat also talked of the lack of cooperation from the janitor at the gym. When asked to have the floor cleaned once in nine months, the job was put off. It is also difficult to get the needed paper supplies for the bathrooms. Selectmen discussed the main concerns and authorized Pat to speak to Keith Burke. Phil will also speak to him and see if they can come to an agreement as to who and when jobs will be done. If the school is willing to loan the town their long ladder, selectmen will hire someone once every four months to replace ceiling tiles etc.

Pat was also told when a parent can't be reached and she has an injured child in her care she can call the rescue squad. Pat had been told there was a charge for this service which was incorrect.

Bob Flanders, Town Moderator, stopped in to acquire a list of petitioners who signed for warrant articles which are not legal. He will contact them to explain the articles are not enforceable.
