A tax payer was in to discuss the elderly exemption. All applications had to be in by April 15th to qualify for the year 1994. In order to qualify for a tax relief whereby the selectmen put a lien on the property, this request will have to be made after the second half of the tax bills for the year. Tax payer will be in sometime in December to apply.

Selectmen reviewed the warrant article that passed at Town Meeting and recalled the discussion which took place at the meeting. Although the Selectmen have and will continue to encourage those using the transfer station to use Route 202 whenever possible, the approval was not contingent on access only from Rte. 202.

Selectmen approve Rick Palmer as a new member of the Fire Department.

Brian Brown, Police Chief came in with a estimates for a new computer for his department. Selectmen approve the purchase of the one recommended by CompuCare of Peterborough.
