

Board of Selectmen  
Town of Antrim  
Minutes of the January 23, 1995 meeting

Selectmen present: Dave Boule, Tom Davis and Phil Dwight.  
Also present were: Bob Flanders, Mike Beauchamps, Dick Edmunds,  
and Bob Bethel.  
Minutes of the January 16, 1995 meeting were approved as written.

Bob Flanders discussed with Selectmen the questions of hours that  
the Polls should be open for Town Elections. It was agreed that  
even though not required, polls should open at 8 A.M. Election  
personnel would be paid \$50 for a full day and \$35 for one half  
day.

Mike Beauchamps and Dick Edmunds and Bob Bethel presented plans  
to purchase equipment that would detect carbon monoxide and other  
gases. It was agreed that their Budget would be increased by  
\$1,000 to accomplish this.

An Intent to Cut for Don Hardwick was signed as well as  
abatements for Forster and New England Timber that has been  
approved at last week's meeting.

Mr. Nobles application for abatement was not accepted as it was  
received past the deadline.

An application for Richard and Gail Sawyer was also denied as it  
was received late but after a review it was agreed that the value  
of their property would be reduced in 1995 from \$19,000 to  
\$11,800.

Correspondence regarding the Antrim and Bennington Water supply  
was reviewed as well as copies of material from Attorney  
Bradley.

Wayno Olson's request for a no parking zone in front of his store  
was taken under advisement.

The proposed warrant for 1995 Town Meeting was reviewed.

It was agreed that no meeting was necessary on January 30.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
