

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting
September 11, 1995

Present: Tom Davis, Peter Moore, Philip Dwight and Egon Ali - Oglu.

The meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. Mr. Ali-Oglu requested that the Selectmen abate part of the interest that was due on taxes owed for 1992, 1993, and 1994.

After discussion the Selectmen voted not to grant such an abatement.

The minutes of the meeting of August 24 were approved.

Selectmen signed an Intent to Cut for Mr. Valeriani, and a T.A.N. note for \$250,000.

The Selectmen discussed the building permit issued as a result of the variance granted by the Z.B.A. for the placement of a manufactured home on a lot on Grove Street. All parties are to be notified that the conditions required by the variance must be strictly adhered to.

The Selectmen agreed to postpone any discussion about the use of the B.O.C.A. code in Antrim until a later date.

The letter from Bennington relative to an agreement on issues still open on the Landfill closure was reviewed. It was voted that the terms outlined were acceptable and the Town's Attorney would be asked to draft the final agreement.

A letter to commercial haulers using the A.R.T.S. is to sent reminding them that they must follow the ordinance about recycling.

It was agreed that the Town will use inventory forms in 1996.

A proposal for a payment plan on back taxes was approved on property at Map 9 Lot 278.

A schedule of Selectmen's Meetings was agreed to for September and October as follows: September 25, October 2, 16 and 30.

Brian Brown will be requested to attend September 25th meeting to discuss the School Crossing situation at West and School Street.

The letter from a property owner on Turner Hill Road was discussed. The legality of their suggestions about handling Intents to Cut will be checked. Bob Varnum will be asked to check the Road to see what repairs can be done.

The meeting adjourned at 9 P.M.
