

Antrim Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the January 15, 1996 meeting

Selectmen present were: Tom Davis, Paula Clemente, Peter Moore and Business Manager Phil Dwight.

Martie Majoros and Tammy McClure representing Project L.I.F.T. were present as well as Ben Pratt, Jim Denisson, Jim Cruthers and Barbara Elia for the Antrim Water/Sewer Commission.

The Meeting opened at 7 P.M. and the representatives of Project L.I.F.T. presented their request for funding. The purpose of the project was discussed as well as the number of participants by Town etc.

At 7:30 the Water and Sewer Commissioners presented their proposal for funding of the "Sludge Removal Project" (see attached). After discussion it was agreed that the Selectmen would support the necessary warrant article requesting a 5 year borrowing with Antrim's cost shared equally between the water and sewer rate payers and the Town.

The minutes of the January 8th meeting were approved. A discussion ensued concerning Project L.I.F.T. and it was decided not to support their request for funding. Phil is to write them.
