Minutes of the March 18, 1996 meeting.

The letter from Chris Baker - Salmon was reviewed. It was agreed that the Board would review the abatement with him and in addition the property would be reviewed with Cole Layer.

Phil was authorized to buy a "lift" for the Transfer Station after checking maintenance and warranty agreements.

Peter will speak with the owner of the property on Map 4 Lot 1111 about which a complaint was received concerning the storage of "junk".

Formal adoption of a Drug Policy was delayed until additional questions can be answered.

The abatement requested of Jane Hill was reviewed. It was agreed to reduce the value of the house (Map 1C lot 606) to \$22,400.

It was agreed that the Board would receive monthly Departmental budget reports and quarterly detailed reports.
