

Minutes of Selectmens Meeting  
July 22, 1996

Selectmen Present: Paula Clemente, Peter Moore and Carol Smith  
Also present were Phil Dwight (for first half hour); Memorial  
Park Committee: Nina Harding, Pat Webber, Bob Allison and Sam  
Harding; Library Trustees: Connie Kerwin and Lyman Gilmore; and  
reporters D. Thornblad from the Villager and B.J. Garcia from the  
Peterborough Transcript.

The meeting opened at 6 P.M.

Plans for Memorial Park as authorized by Town Meeting were  
discussed. It was agreed that the first priority was to install  
drainage pipes. Second would be for one bathroom, handicap  
accessible. There also would be additional lighting for evening  
events. Pat and Nina are to obtain specific cost estimates and  
present them to the selectmen as soon as possible.

At 6:30 P.M. the Library Trustees discussed possible solutions to  
the driveway situation at the Library. All concerned, again  
expressed their apologies for the lack of communication, but also  
all still expressed their feeling that the best solution was to  
have one way traffic. If that is not possible Peter suggested  
signs encouraging, not mandating, one way traffic. Decisions on  
paving and final course of action will be decided next week.

Based on the letter from all residents on a section of Gregg Lake  
Drive, it was voted to change the name of that section to Rachel  
Lane. This involves numbers 15 and higher. All concerned are to  
be notified.

A letter to residents of 2nd NH Turnpike was approved requesting  
their input into the possibility of turning that road back to  
gravel.

A decision on the possible demolition of the buildings on the  
property to be auctioned was postponed until next week.

Peter will talk to a property owner about PSNH's trimming trees  
on that property.

The Selectmen agreed to order a set of prints of the Town Hall  
Tower Paintings. Current and Past Selectmen will be asked to  
donate towards the cost. The prints will be displayed at Town  
Hall.

The Selectmen will meet with FACT representatives on Aug.5th.

Jim Dennison's letter offering his resignation as a Trustee of Trust Funds was noted. The other Trustees will be consulted about when they feel this would be accepted and whether they know of a possible replacement.

Phil was asked to get estimates on various repairs at the Aiken Building per the report of Keith Dubois.

The next meeting will be July 29th.

The meeting was adjourned at 8 P.M.
