

Minutes of Selectmens Meeting  
October 28, 1996

The meeting was called to order at 6 P.M.

The Board voted to go into Executive Session to discuss a  
personnel matter.

The Board reconvened at 6:15 in open session. They announced no  
decisions were made in executive session.

Phil reviewed with the Board the choices they had to make  
relative to the 1997 Medical Insurance Rates and indicated that  
as the Town needed to notify the Trust as to their decision by  
November 15th, such decision should be made no later than  
November 4th.

Phil left the meeting at 6:45 P.M. (above minutes taken by him)

Bob Varnum joined the meeting as did the residents from  
Contoocook Valley Ave. The residents reviewed their concerns and  
Bob Varnum was asked to look at the problem and return next week  
with two plans to review with Selectmen.

With regard to Old Turnpike Road, Selectmen decided not to salt  
in front of the Forster residence and watch that section of the  
road for problems.

Brian Brown joined the meeting and told the Selectmen that Dan  
Bigda had resigned. It was agreed that advertisements for a  
replacement should be placed immediately. The Selectmen  
requested that Dan come to the November 4th meeting.

The Water & Sewer Commissioners joined the meeting to discuss the  
Medical Rates for 1997.

The October 21st minutes were approved as amended.

The proposed Wood policy was discussed and is to be finalized at  
the next meeting.

Notes from the Regional Selectmens Meeting were distributed.

The Selectmen agreed that they would spend one hour at the end of  
each future meeting to discuss the ~~proposed~~ personnel policy.

The meeting adjourned at 9:20 P.M.
