

Minutes of the Selectmens Meeting
February 17, 1997

Selectmen Present: Peter Moore, Carol Smith and Michael Oldershaw.

Also present were: Philip Dwight, Brian Brown and Mr. & Mrs. Morrill.

At 6:00 P.M. the Selectmen met with Mr. & Mrs. Morrill and Brian Brown to discuss the parking situation in the area between the Village Store and the Video Store. After a long discussion with them, and then after they had left,(and eventually after viewing the lot later that evening) it was agreed that the Morrills will be asked to agree to the following plan:

Three spaces in front of the store will be assigned for the use of the store's customers during the hours that the store is open - signs will be posted to that effect. The Morrill's will be responsible for the maintenance of these spaces. Such agreement will be continued as long as the Morrill's property is run as a store. If the use changes this agreement will be voided.
