1) Gobin - Spot Market Charge 75.67 per Ton  
(NO) guarantee

2) Naughton + Son  
Compactor + Container Rental (40 yd) 400 per month  
(based on average TONAGE of 12 TONS  
Per haul - 500 TONS per year then  
equals  $\longrightarrow$  9.60 Per Ton  
Haulage  $\$125$  per trip  $\times$  41.67 trips a year  
equals  $\longrightarrow$  10.42 per Ton  
Tipping Fee per TON 55.00  
(NO) Guarantee 75.02 Total

3) Waste Management  
Rental - 195 per month = 4.68 per TON  
Disposal  $\$170$  per TON based on 500 TONS per year  
Total Cost 74.68 per TON  
Rate guaranteed - CPI increases

4) Cheshire Sanitation  
Rental 250 : Haulage 126 : Disposal 46 per TON  
Based on 500 TONS per year + 10 TONS per haul  
this equals =  $\$64.60$  per TON  
Rate guaranteed - CPI increases
