MAY 8, 2000**

PRESENT: Chairman Eric Tenney, Selectman Phil Dwight and Secretary Sherry Miller.

6:00 p.m. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

STEPS FOR TOWN HALL MOVE –

Selectmen Tenney and Dwight agreed to have signs made and put up at specific locations advising the public where the town office has moved. The Selectmen's office will put something in the next Limrik and they will also do a bulk mailing.

The tentative moving dates are PD 6/8 and the Town Office 6/16.

TREE REMOVAL –

There is one tree that needs to be removed in order for the renovations at the Aiken House to begin, the Committee stated that there may be others, Selectmen Tenney and Dwight will consult with the Tree Service to see what they feel is necessary.

AIKEN HOUSE PROJECT –

There was some discussion as to what the Selectmen's role is regarding the Aiken House Project. The Selectmen agree that they will sign any necessary papers, but it is ultimately up to the Committee to do what needs to be done and to stay within the budget.

6:30 – 7:00 DAVE ESSEX RE: TIF –

Dave Essex met with the Selectmen to discuss the Tax Increment Finance District (TIF). Mr. Essex stated that a TIF Advisory Board & Administrator needed to be appointed by the Selectmen. Mr. Essex stated that the Committee would consist of five members, three would need to live within the TIF District and two would need to live within the Town of Antrim. Mr. Essex supplied the Board with several approachable towns' people that may be interested in sitting on the TIF Advisory Board. Selectmen Tenney and Dwight agreed to contact some of the individuals on the list but asked Mr. Essex to "rank" who should be called first.

7:00 – 7:30 MILLENNIUM COMMITTEE –

Selectmen Tenney and Dwight met with the Members of the Millennium Committee to discuss the planned Millennium Celebration in August 2000. The first item discussed was a letter received from Sara Edwards requesting a letter from the Selectmen about Antrims future. Selectman Dwight suggested that the Millennium Committee contact Ed Rowehl, Chairman of the Planning Board.

The committee supplied the Selectmen with a tentative schedule for August 12 & 13. The committee stated that they invited the Fire Chief and Chief Brown to this meeting so

that they are aware of their plans, Fire Chief Mike Beauchamp was present. Chief Brown had a prior engagement and was unable to attend; however Sara Edwards has spoken with him about their tentative schedule. Fire Chief Beauchamp asked if the fireworks would be at the same location as last time? It was stated they would probably be shot off of the private beach off of White Birch Point. Seeing that there will be a lot of activities around town and at the beach the committee suggested having EMT's from the Antrim Ambulance on duty. Chief Beauchamp stated that the Fire Department would take care of that, he also suggested having a fire truck at the end of Gregg Lake so that if there was a call the truck could exit via Craig Road.

Selectman Dwight inquired if they would have enough money for the festivities that they have planned? The committee stated that they believe that they will.

Sara Edwards stated they had planned to put an article in the Limrik, but wanted to know if they could use the town's bulk mail permit to send to all residents a schedule of events. Selectmen Tenney and Dwight agreed that they could use the permit.

Pam Caswell inquired if there could be a Jr. Muster, Chief Beauchamp will bring it up at the Fire Departments next meeting.

Review and approve the April 24, 200 Minutes –

Selectmen Tenney and Dwight approved the minutes of April 24, 2000.

There being no further business to come before the Board the meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
