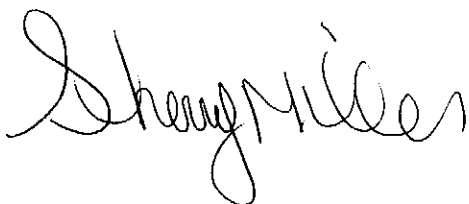
The Selectmen agreed to continue to have Wallace Press print the Town Report.
