6:30 p.m. Bob Flanders / Peter Moore


Mr. Flanders met with the Selectmen to discuss the procedure to be used on Thursday night. Peter Moore stated that the Conservation Commission did not get the LCHIP grant that they were hoping for and as a result they would like to amend their warrant article #3 to increase the amount to be raised from taxes from \$20,000 to \$40,000. The Selectmen agreed to continue to support the article. However, Mr. Flanders would like Town Council notified to be sure that a 50% increase is permissible.

The Selectmen reviewed a letter received from the Office of State Planning addressing questions about the ramifications of demolition of the Aiken House. The Selectmen will put this letter with the Town Report for public review.
