Alan Treadwell presented a contract for the computer upgrade in the amount of \$15,250.00. Mr. Treadwell pointed out that there were additional costs involved due to requirements from Proval in order to obtain certain reports. After reviewing the contract with Earls, Neider, and Perkins it's believed that any software upgrades are included in the revaluation cost. The Selectmen are scheduled to meet with the Revaluation Company on Thursday and they will verify that the software is included.

7:45 – Antrim Recycling Committee –

Committee Members present: Chairperson Dotty Penny, Kelly Pale, Clark Craig, Ruth Benedict, Jim Bingham and Dennis Slocumb from D.C. Slocumb.


The Committee has been discussing the possibility of getting a baler for which they have received a grant. The problem they have been faced with is whether or not a baler is the most feasible way to go. Their intention is to recycle more to decrease the amount going into the compactor. Dennis Slocumb offered various options but couldn't advise them to go one way or the other. He also offered to show them what other Town's are doing, again not indicating whether what they are doing is right or wrong.
