The Selectmen had sent a letter, which addressed 10 issues, each issue was individually addressed with only a few minor concerns which Keith Burke will bring back to the Budget & Property Department. It was also discussed that there may be a need to have the agreement reviewed annually or possibly bi-annually. Once an agreement is complete it will be forwarded to the Selectmen for their review and opinion.

Landfill Closure Grant –

Selectman Prokop was informed that there might be a delay in receiving the anticipated landfill closure grant. The Department of Environmental Services is still waiting for water testing information from the Town of Bennington, before the grant is released. The Business Manager will contact Bill Reid to get clarification.

All base values for all districts have been received. There were a few questions that have been faxed that will hopefully be answered at the next meeting, which is August 5, 2002.
