5) 6:40 John Deline, 73 Fitchburg Rd, Continued septic variance hearing Jim Burgoyne –Fletcher, Tilton and Whipple Richard Boutwell

Before the hearing even began Wayne Adams became verbally very disruptive and was asked to leave the meeting, he refused and the police were called to remove Mr.Adams from the meeting. The police arrived and escorted Mr. Adams from the meeting.

Glen read aloud Deb Phillips conclusion to the questions submitted to the board. Rick produced a document presented to him by the Adams which they felt showed that the site was still contaminated. Deb Phillips stated that the engineering document was not on the record and really should not affect the proposed variances. Jim Burgoyne explained that the site has been closed and that there never was a soil issue, but a potential bedrock ground water issue. The board has no evidence that there is any soil contamination.

The item that bothered the board was the statement that the site was approaching background. According to Deb Phillips there are no legal restrictions for proceeding with a septic permit.

Another thing the Adams brought up was that everyone who was affected by the plan needed to be notified. Since the case has been closed legally there is no need to follow up on this.

Another concern from the Adams was the migration of toxins once the site is opened.

Glen raised the proposal of testing before opening the site. Jim Bugoyne retorted that further testing would be a severe hardship for Mr. Boutwell.

The Board proposed that the LSP be on site when digging begins with a pid meter to determine if there is the presence of any toxins and with the conditions that any material transported off site must be done in accordance with all applicable regulations. All unanimously agreed.

John Deline re-presented the variances: Offset from leaching form 100ft to 50 ft Local upgrade reduction groundwater 4ft to 3ft Local upgrade reduction from the tank inlet to groundwater 12 to 1inch

Scott motioned to approve the variances Unanimously approved

6) 6:50 Ken Holmquist, 142 Ashby Road progress report

Could not come in. Rick paraphrased a call from Mr. Holmquist. He was asked to come to the Aug. 3rd meeting. Mr. Holmquist has not yet received approval from the DEP. The board had asked for a water test. Rick asked if the board want to require an annual test on the well. The board will require an annual coliform test and **this restriction must be placed on the deed.**

The board modified he order to appear, and an extension to Sept. 14th to require a basic well scan. The board will require an annual chloroform test.

The Board will allow approval out of meeting when DEP rules on groundwater offset
