Request for tight tank permit BRPWWOY. The tight tank was all ready installed due to emergency status. Variances:

1. Reduction in offset from groundwater to inlet of tank

2. 50' to 48' distance of well from system

Scott motioned, Patrick seconded. Unanimous approval. See attached green cards.

- 6:50 Northland Engineering representing Mike Hebert, 125 Dunn Road Variance: 310CMR15.405:1 Reduction of 4' offset to 3' for the estimated seasons high H₂O. Scott motioned, Tom seconded, voted on and approved unanimous.

 - 1. 310CMR15.212(1) offset to the estimated seasons high water down to 2-1/2'

 - To allow a sieve analysis in lieu of a perc test W/A condition of yearly testing of well water for chloroform. At the beginning of project a title five scan (of well) Scott motioned, Patrick seconded, voted on and approved unanimous
