To submit an online application, you must have a valid driver’s license, learner’s permit or non-driver ID issued by the Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV). You must also have a signature on file with the RMV. This system can be used to:**
  - **Apply to register to vote in Massachusetts**
  - **Change your name or address for voter registration purposes**
  - **Enroll in a political party, change your party enrollment, or unenroll from a party.****PLEASE NOTE: THE LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THE MARCH 1, 2016 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY OR TO MAKE CHANGES TO YOUR REGISTRATION IS WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2016.** (full information on this new feature is attached to this agenda)
- February 2<sup>nd</sup> – Final Registration for Citizens Caucus at Town Clerk’s office – 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- February 10<sup>th</sup> – Last day to register to vote and change party enrollment for presidential primary – Town Clerk’s office – 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

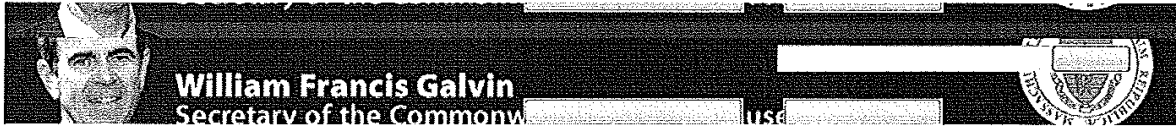
- February 22<sup>nd</sup> – Citizens Caucus – 7:00 p.m. – Stevens Memorial Library, Malcolm Stewart Room.

## Online Voter Registration System

**NOTICE:** The last day to register to vote in the March 1, 2016 Presidential Primaries, or to make changes to your registration, is Wednesday, February 10, 2016.

**Welcome** to the Online Voter Registration System. To submit an online application, you must have a valid driver's license, learner's permit, or non-driver ID issued by the Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV). You must also have a signature on file with the RMV.

If you don't have an RMV ID, you can still use the online system to create an application. **PRINT** and sign the completed form, and then mail or bring it to your local election official.

**Use this online system to:**

- apply to register to vote in Massachusetts
- change your name or address for voter registration purposes
- enroll in a political party, change your party enrollment, or unenroll from a party
