PUBLIC INPUT:

• There was no public input because no public attended the meeting.

AGENDA:

- Review the capital plans for both towns
- Discuss possible equipment items for regionalization

After reviewing the Ashburnham – Westminster Capital Planning list, the following was discussed:

--Equipment pros: work history; equipment longevity.

--Equipment cons: Requesting use of same equipment at the same time; questioning the savings on purchasing big ticketed items; equipment already purchased by one town thus unable to purchase together.

--Possible items to purchase together: Loader and Sweeper.

--Are both towns willing to engage in sharing the equipment AKA "time share?"

--It was decided to have the Town Administrators from both towns send an email to their Department Heads to ask which particular pieces of equipment pieces the Department Heads believed could be shared by both towns. Also, is Ashburnham/Westminster the correct match to share equipment?

--It was the belief of the two town member committee that the Department Heads have the experience and expertise to decide equipment regionalization.

--After receipt of the Department Head list, the list will be the report that is due by September 30, 2010.
