

MEETING MINUTES OF THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION Monday, June 12th, 2017 6:30 P.M.

Town Hall – Lower Level Meeting Room

6:30 PM: Agenda Review/General Discussion

CP opened the meeting of the Ashburnham Conservation Commission under the MA Wetland Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40, and in accordance with the Ashburnham Wetlands Protection Bylaw and associated Rules and Regulations.

6:35 PM – Michael Kaskiewicz: 50 Hilltop Drive – Notice of Intent: Septic System Upgrade and associated grading within the 100-foot buffer zone of Lake Watatic.

Angel Lehtonen of Northland Engineers was in attendance representing the Applicant.

As part of the replacement septic system, Ms. Lehtonen explained that a 40 mil polymerbased barrier would be placed around the leach field, thereby reducing the area required and the chance of contaminant migration to the lake. The actual area of buffer zone disturbance will be approximately 1,295 square feet. Upon project completion, disturbed areas will be loamed and seeded.

With respect to erosion controls, Ms. Lehtonen stated that silt fencing could not be directly connected to the shed at the corner of driveway since the property line/shed location issues. Therefore, the Commission noted that while the lot is relatively flat, a sufficient number of straw bales will be required to be onsite in case of a severe storm event and to prevent sediment-laden storm runoff from reaching Lake Watatic.

Lastly, Ms. Lehtonen stated that the Board of Health permit had not yet been issued.

CP motioned to close the Hearing for 50 Hilltop Drive. LC seconded. Approved 3 - 0.

CP motioned to approve the NOI and issue an Order of Conditions per plan and discussion. LC seconded. Approved 3 - 0.

CP acknowledged that the Commission had received a Request for Extension relative to the Order of Conditions for 73 West Shore Drive. CP motioned to adjourn. LC seconded. Approved 3 – 0.
