OVERRIDE #1: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to assess an additional \$421,795.76 in real estate and personal property taxes, for the purpose of funding a portion of salaries and expenses for general government operations, for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003?

CAPITAL OUTLAY EXPENDITURE EXCLUSION #2: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to assess an additional \$130,000 in real estate and personal property taxes for the purpose of reconstructing town roads and sidewalks for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003?

DEBT EXCLUSION #3: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition 2½, so called, the amounts required to pay for the bond to be issued in order to finance the purchase of a new ambulance?

OVERRIDE #4: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to assess an additional \$844,953 in real estate and personal property taxes, for the purpose of adding such sum to line 19A, Ashburnham-Westminster Regional School District, for the budget approved under Article 2 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003?
