- Continued discussion of DPW property future use. It was determined the property is classified as a browns field site. Based on the past charette there was consensus on a development that would include commercial buildings with apartments above and additional multi-family units interspersed on the parcel. The currently revised zoning now allows for more than one principle building on a parcel and multi-family housing is allowed. Units greater than three dwelling units will require a special permit from the Planning Board. The main concerns are the sewer capacity, status of the 21E report and who has ownership of any problems. Planning Board will put together a report and request a meeting with the Board of Selectmen.
