Flo Chemical ROW – their property has been rezoned. Sallie will meet with the Manager, Robert Karpiuk, and invited him to our June meeting. Owners Paul and Joel Freeman were invited to our July meeting.

Sallie informed us that the piece of land referred to as "the triangle" is now owned by us. Land Court, lot 48, map 51. Land Court, lot 48, map 51.

About the Cheshire Line – Sallie spoke with Darlene from the railroad company (Pan-Am Railways). We have to tell them exactly what we want to buy. The parcel, in question, is 40.3 acres and 3-4 miles long.

Some grant resources to look into are: Urban Self-Help Program that needs an application by the end of July. Recreational Trails Program by Oct. 1st. Safe Routes to School. We need to speak with the School Dept. at a later date. Apply to the Mt. Grace Land Trust for a grant.

The Cheshire Line will be on the ACT Agenda.

We need to consider safety factors, allowing snowmobiling, etc. in reference to this area.

Mark Dymek Land Swap is in the works. A hearing was held in April.
