

ARTICLE 1:

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money up to \$475,656 for the operating budget of the Ashburnham-Westminster Regional School District, to be added to the sum voted under Article 9 of the May 2, 2017 Annual Town meeting, for said operating budget, provided that no funds shall be expended and no bonds shall be issued unless the Town has first voted at an election to exempt this expenditure from the provisions of Proposition 2½, so called, and further provided that the Town of Westminster also votes to approve and fund its proportional share of such additional appropriations, or act in relation thereto. *(Requested by the Board of Selectmen)*
