August 13, 2012

I. Call to order

Bill Johnson called to order a special Public Hearing meeting of the **VMS Building Use Committee** at **6:30pm** on **August 13th 2012** in the Public Safety Building Training Room.

III. Opening – Bill Johnson

- b) Explanation of the VMS Use Committee and what our role is.
- c) Introduction of each committee member

IV. Discussion, Comments & Questions

- a) The building was built in 1949 and is not a historical building. It would be approx.
 - 1.6 m to update and that doesn't include the underground tanks.
 - Approx. \$100,000 \$150,000 to tear down w/o asbestos or remediation.
 - It will be about \$2500 to have an engineering company walk through and determine where hazards are. No matter what is decided the tanks and asbestos need to be dealt with.
 - The building is not energy efficient. The NCSC who currently least the building went through 4000 gal of oil in 4 months. The radiators never turn off.
- b) Question: What information has the committee gathered.
 - Answer: Feasibility Study, Highway Barn Site Charrette Study, 1983 Inititiave Study by Malcolm Stewart. We've also toured the building, emailed and invited all town committees to meet with us and sent letters to all abutters.
- c) Q. What is the value? A. \$354,000 the whole lot is appraised at \$3,366,800
- d) Q. Is the building structurally sound? A. We believe so.
- e) Q. Can solar panels be placed on VMS building instead of Library?
 - A. Mark believes there was a roof issue so that isn't possible.
- f) Other comments:
 - Keeping building could be economical
 - Suggested Rehab, Replace, Demolish
 - Cons- Can't be subdivided, Limited Parking, Limited Resources,
 - Some abutters were not very receptive to the thought of expanding the playground due to ongoing vandalism.
 - Unfortunately a lot of old historic buildings are being torn down everywhere it would be nice to honor the Veterans
 - We have a community center already the Bresnhan Center.
 - Guest if she owned a building worth \$300,000 but didn't have the money to fix it, she wouldn't tear it down as a solution
