The Water Dept did recheck to see if the reading was correct which it was. No determination has been made why the consumption was so large. The Commissioners waited until the May 10 meeting to make a decision to see what the next quarter billing read. The April billing was back on track and the Commissioners did not approved Ms. Ducharme's request for abatement.
- Bernadette Clark, 12 Central Street met with the Commissioners April 12, 2011 complaining that her usage was always high. Mrs. Clark was supposed to make an appointment to verify her meter was working correctly. Mrs. Clark has not contact the Water Dept. Withdrawn
