Randy Brown from Tighe & Bond gave the status update on the 5 water tank purchase items. Rural Development needs to sign off on the change order for the tank mixer, security cameras and the telemetry system. *Note: The cameras need the state engineer to sign off on the approval for this item. No pricing has been received yet on the variable speed motors – Tighe & Bond estimates that the motors will cost around \$60,000-\$70,000. Randy will instruct Five Oaks to get bids.

Contact #2: Blasting mats need to be removed, tree replacement and re-seed tank site. Leo asked if there was any additional monies leftover he would like to use the monies to install around the tank and the old well house.

NEW BUSINESS

Randy discussed the possibility of Tighe & Bond doing a water main project on Williams Rd. Leo stated that some funding may come from a delinquent Water/Sewer customer that is in arrears.

Resident: Marilyn Clark – 15 Puffer St has requested a one time abatement from her February water bill due to leak that she was unaware of and has since repaired.

unanimous.

COMMISSIONERS REPORT

Leo spoke briefly on the ASR that he generated from our data and placed together in a binder format by Melissa from Veolia. The report was presented to all the commissioners and was also provided to the Town Administrator, Selectman and various department heads.

Leo spoke also on the water consumption used and the amounts lately are higher. This was reported by the Water treatment plant in just the last 2 months. Leo feels that spring will bring water leaks once the frost is gone.
