CALL TO ORDER

OLD BUSINESS

-Leo stated to the commissioners that the water tank project is complete and all monies have been spent down to the last \$ 33.00. Leo also reminded the commission that the Water Line project bid opening is set for June 5th at 2pm and that there will be a pre-construction meeting held on May 29th at 10am if anyone is interested in attending.

NEW BUSINESS

Leo allowed resident and abutter to the reservoir to present his planned presentation to the commissioners. Paul provided the commissioner with a proposal to allow only immediate abutters to the reservoir to have boating rights. He stated that the island owners already are excluded from the ban and so should the abutters. Leo asked the commissioners to discuss Mr. Maguire's presentation. George Cornwall offer a motion to read: I move to amend the original vote taken on July 17, 2014 that the water commissioners allow the abutters to the Upper Naukeag reservoir be allowed to have and use two boats on the Upper Naukeag Lake. Said abutters will follow all rules and regulations imposed by the Ashburnham water commissioners in effect now and in the future, voted 3 yes- 2 no, vote does pass.

Leo asked to advertise an ad about the boating ban in the local newspaper so that all residents are made aware of the original and now the amended ban.

COMMISSIONERS REPORT

Leo asked Steve for an update on the latest on the up-coming Water line Project. Steve stated the bid opening date and pre-construction meeting. He stated that approximately a dozen or so contractors had pulled plans so far as possible bidders.
