# Motion by Val Daigle to raise the sewer rate from \$ 12.00 to \$ 13.25 effective the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter November 2015 billing, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Berger, vote was unanimous

Mary gave the update on paving the remaining streets on the water project and that we are at the mercy of Mass Broken Stone. Charlie was not happy as it was stated that it would be within two weeks presented by Doug at the last BOS meeting.

# COMMISSIONERS REPORT
