Minutes

The meeting of the Auburn City Council was called to order at 6:00PM in the City Council Chambers 24 South St. Auburn NY by Councilor McCormick.

1. Roll Call – The City Clerk called the roll. Councilors McCormick, Camardo, Cuddy, and Ruzicka were all present. Mayor Quill was excused.

A. City Manager's Report

- The Manager reported that the City has been notified that the New York State Department of Transportation will be paving a section of Route 34 in the City. The section will be on the area of North Street between Seymour Street and the Auburn Police Department building on the Arterial. Thanks go out to Senator DeFrancisco for his assistance with addressing this matter.
- The Owasco Lake level is being managed by the City according to restrictions placed on the process by State regulations. Heavy snowmelt and spring rains can make the process challenging.
- Mill Street Dam has been operating at full capacity in recent weeks due to the heavy snowmelt and spring rains.
- The refinanced bonds that were approved by Council a few weeks ago will save the City \$81,000.00 spread out over the next several years.

F. Staff/Vendor Presentations –

F1. Presentation on Fire Apparatus Replacement and Debt Stabilization Reserve

Fire Chief Jeff Dygert and City Comptroller Laura Wills made a presentation on Fire Apparatus Replacement and the Debt Stabilization Reserve that was budgeted in the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 City budget.

F2. Preliminary Budget Presentation

City Comptroller Laura Wills provided a preliminary 2015-2016 City Budget Presentation. This was a presentation on where the City staff currently is on compiling a budget and was not a proposed budget.

F3. Discussion of Road Program

The City Manager Doug Selby outlined roads that will be paved in the spring of 2015 that are leftover from the 2014 City road program. He also discussed ways that the City can approach the City Road Program in 2015 and specifically discussed using seasonal labor to repair roads.

10. Other Business

A. Councilor Cuddy discussed the proposal for entering an application for the Governor's NY Prize program. He stated that the NY Prize program is intended to benefit communities that lost power after the devastating hurricane Sandy of 2012. He does not want to see Auburn, which did not lose power or suffer damage from hurricane Sandy, compete with communities that did lose power and suffer extreme damage as a result of the devastating storm.

- B. Councilor Ruzicka discussed the company that is willing to prepare the NY Prize application. He asked the City Manager about the company and expense associated with endeavor.
- C. Camardo discussed the importance of Auburn Community Hospital in the community and encouraged the City Manager and City Council to keep in communication with the hospital administration.
