## FINANCIAL RESOLUTION # 5 OF 2015

## AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE DORMITORY AUTHORITY OF NEW YORK STATE FOR RENOVATIONS AT CLIFFORD FIELD CLUBHOUSE

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn owns and operates Clifford Park and the Y-Field that has been in use as a recreational facility since 1898 and serves an important role in the community's recreational history; and

WHEREAS, the clubhouse at Clifford Field has been identified in the FY 2014-2018 City Capital Improvement Program plan as requiring capital improvements to the building's first floor interior and general exterior; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Auburn submitted a request to Senator John A. DeFrancisco for funding assistance to implement renovations at the Clifford Park clubhouse; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this request, the City of Auburn has received a State and Municipal Facilities Program grant from the Dormitory Authority of New York State (DASNY) in the sum of \$75,000; and

**WHEREAS,** the Mayor of the City of Auburn must be authorized to accept the grant funding and execute all necessary documents in connection therewith prior to commencing the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, that the Mayor of the City of Auburn is hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract agreement with the Dormitory Authority of New York State for renovations at the Clifford Field Clubhouse through a State and Municipal Facilities Program grant for Project ID: #6467, in the amount of \$75,000 to be charged to the Clifford Field Clubhouse Renovation Project (capital account No. HA 7110.440 HQ).
