COUNCIL RESOLUTION 8 of 2015

ESTABLISHING LANDFILL RATES

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn is the owner and operator of a landfill situated on North Division Street within the City of Auburn and the City incurs operating costs for this landfill; and

WHEREAS, the City utilizes the landfill for the deposit of municipal solid waste collected within the City of Auburn and also does accept municipal solid waste and construction and demolition waste from other municipalities and private haulers; and

WHEREAS, the City has established and contracted with private haulers in the past for the deposit of municipal solid waste and construction demolition waste at specified rates per ton of these materials and those rates were last modified by Council Resolution #15 of 2014; and

WHEREAS, in recent years the City has conducted lengthy studies related to the operation costs of the landfill and the necessity for adjusting rates to outside haulers and as a result of the studies which have been conducted, and upon further review of revenues since the adoption of Council Resolution #15 of 2014 the Auburn City Council does desire to establish new rates in order to establish agreements with waste haulers and that said new rates should be as follows:

City of Auburn, NY Landfill Tipping Fee Schedule for contracted private haulers or other municipalities beginning January 1, 2015
Rate for the first 50 tons monthly:

Construction and Demolition (C&D) Waste

\$55.00 per ton

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)

\$55.00 per ton

Rates for tons above 50 tons monthly may be negotiated with the City Manager or the City Superintendent of Public Works not to drop below \$35 per ton without City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the negotiated discounted rate may be subject to a place or pay stipulation; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to produce adequate methane with which to provide the landfill gas to electricity plant the City will monitor C&D waste and shall alter intake if C&D tonnage exceeds 10% of total tonnage intake.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Auburn City Council does hereby establish a new fee schedule for contracted private haulers or other municipalities at new rates set according to the new fee schedule listed in this Resolution said rates to begin on January 1, 2015; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements implementing the new rates for the landfill that do not require further Council approval as specified in this Resolution.
