

AGREEMENT RESOLUTION #25 OF 2015

**AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH
BEARDSLEY AND PACHECO ROSS ARCHITECTS FOR THE
REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY COMPLEX PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn Police and Fire buildings located at 46 North Street and 23 Market Street were constructed c. 1930 and have served as the public safety headquarters for the City of Auburn for the last 85 years; and

WHEREAS, the existing police and fire headquarter buildings require extensive capital infrastructure improvements in regards to ADA public access, the police command center modernization and locker rooms, the fire apparatus bay and training rooms as well as various other projects to comply with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn is exploring the feasibility of constructing a new Regional Public Safety Complex and has released a Request for Qualifications and received proposals from four (4) qualified firms; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has selected the proposal from Beardsley and Pacheco Ross in the amount not to exceed \$70,000 for professional services related to a needs assessment, program development, land use planning, intergovernmental coordination, and RFP development for the Regional Public Safety Complex project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Auburn, New York, that it does hereby authorize the Mayor to enter into a professional services agreement with Beardsley of Auburn, New York and Pacheco Ross of Voorheesville, NY at a cost not to exceed \$70,000 to be charged to a capital account entitled Regional Public Safety Complex (#HA1620.440.HT).
