AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH C&S ENGINEERS, INC. FOR THE NORTH DIVISION STREET DAM HYDRO PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$1,200,000 from New York State Empire State Development to implement smart grid and facility improvements at the North Division Street Dam Hydroelectric Facility (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, these facility improvements include, but are not limited to, site preparation and construction of a new powerhouse building, removal and replacement of the turbine and generator systems, repairs and replacement of the power channel as well as the trash rake system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has issued a Request for Qualifications for professional engineering services related to the completion of the proposed scope of work for the North Division Street Dam hydroelectric facility; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2015 the City of Auburn received five (5) responses to the Request for Qualifications and through a competitive review process, C&S Engineers, Inc. of Syracuse, NY was selected with a proposed fee not to exceed \$329,520.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Auburn, New York, that it does hereby authorize the Mayor to enter into a professional services agreement with C&S Engineers, Inc. of Syracuse, New York at a cost not to exceed \$329,520.00 to be charged to a designated capital account entitled North Division Street Hydro Upgrade (#ED 8292 440 HY).
