Rules For Bringing Waste To a Collection Day

- **ü** Bring your waste in its original containers whenever possible.
- ü Do not mix different products.
- **ü** Collect your waste containers in disposable boxes or bins, which should be transported in your trunk. Do not put your Household Hazardous Waste in the backseat with your children or pets.
- **ü** STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE! The MDC will handle everything for you.
- **ü** NO SMOKING IN YOUR CAR! Most wastes are flammable.
- **ü** Bring something to read, the wait is usually 5-15 minutes, but can be up to 30 minutes.
- **ü** If possible, leave children and animals at home.

Listed below are common household hazardous wastes, which can be brought to a collection day. This list is not all encompassing; there may be other hazardous items or chemicals in your home.
