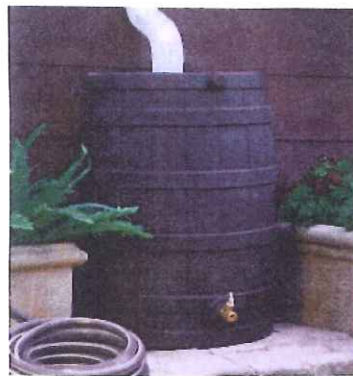
Rain Barrels will be made available, on a first come – first serve basis

Proof of Residency Required



Thirty four (34) brown, forty gallon plastic resin rain barrels will be available (must be picked up) for residents of Avon at no cost, on a first come-first serve basis, as part of a CT DEP Residential Stormwater Management Project. The rain barrels are 28.25 L x 21.50 W x 28.25 H inches. They come with a flat back design, screened inlet and brass spigot.
