## • Approval of Minutes

- o GL moved to approve the minutes for 11/14/2012 as written; MF 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - Motion approved unanimously.

### • Discussion: Consultant Jen Goldson

- o BS contacted Ms. Goldson to see if she would be interested in working with CPC on:
  - Reviewing the Town's Open Space acquisition priorities
  - Renewing the Town's Open Space and Recreation Plan (OSRP)
- Ms. Goldson is interested and would be available to meet with CPC at its 3/6/13 meeting.
  - BS suggested to Ms. Goldson that she prepare a draft of her scope of services for review.
- JM said Parks & Recreation has the most up-to-date hard copy of the now expired OSRP.
  - He will check to see if there is an electronic version available.
- GL will email Glenn Eaton at Montachusett Regional Planning Commission (MRPC) to see if Geographic Information Services (GIS) would be available to the Town through MRPC.
  - BS said GIS services would be useful in analyzing what areas would be good for Open Space acquisition, etc.

# Discussion: Potential Open Space acquisition – Kohler Place

- JP will talk to Ed Cornelier, representing the Sandy Pond Investment Trust, regarding concerns raised by the Conservation Commission in evaluating this property for potential Town purchase.
- o The concerns include:
  - Undocumented affirmation legal statement as to crossing rights over a narrow strip at the end of Wright Road;
  - High cost of the parcel relative to what the Town would also have to pay to prepare for purchase and make the parcel available to residents;



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- Potential for need for a Phase II environmental review given parcel previously owned by a company (Boston Ice Company) and that a tannery used to be located further uphill from the wetlands.
- o JP will also let Mr. Cornelier know more about the tax advantages available if the parcel were to be set aside as a Conservation Restriction.

### • Discussion: Reduction in size of CPC from 9 to 7 members

- o GL will contact Town Counsel to draft the Warrant Article for Spring Town Meeting.
  - The Article will be written to eliminate mandatory representation from the Board of Selectmen and from the Financial Committee.
    - This would not prevent members of either board from filling one of the At-Large positions if so desired.

#### New Business

- Set-Asides for Spring Town Meeting
  - GL said Town Accountant Lisa Gabree will not have figures for distribution ready until March.
  - GL said the State will be looking at a shortfall this year in State CPA contributions because of recent lawsuits involving a State testing lab and a meningitis outbreak.
