# • Confirmation of the Agenda

- o TT moved to confirm the agenda as posted; LC 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - Motion approved unanimously.

#### Conservation Administrator Job Interview

- o Danielle Mucciarone was interviewed again for the CA vacancy.
  - Having missed the first interview, LC took the lead in asking questions.
- o Following the interview, ConCom members held a brief discussion.
  - JG summarized comments she received from a check of Ms. Mucciarone's references.
- o JG moved that ConCom extend a job offer to Ms. Mucciarone and recommend her name to the Board of Selectmen for hire as the new Conservation Administrator; TT 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - GB asked JG to confirm the hourly rate with Town Accountant Lisa Gabree.
  - Motion approved unanimously.
  - GB will contact BD with the news so that BD may extend an offer.

## • Discussion: ZBA Request for Comments, 15 Littleton Road

- o ConCom members reviewed the application for a variance for a new gas station, on the rotary, that will be coming before the ZBA.
  - It was unclear from the drawing where wetlands were on the parcel.
- O ConCom's comments will ask that ZBA confirm that no work is planned within the 100 ft. buffer zone.
  - If work does fall within the buffer zone, the wetlands will need to be flagged and the applicant will need to come before ConCom.

## Office Updates

- o A member of the Autumn Ridge Homeowners Association, Peg Pfeiffer, contacted ConCom asking what they need to provide in order to secure a Certificate of Compliance.
- o JG has already told Ms. Pfeiffer of the need for engineer-certified as-builts.
  - The developer is no longer part of the picture and Ms. Pfeiffer said it was doubtful they would be able to get any further information or material from the developer.
  - TT and GB said the best course the Association now has would be to contact Goldsmith, Prest & Ringwall, the engineering firm for the development, for help with providing the as-builts.
